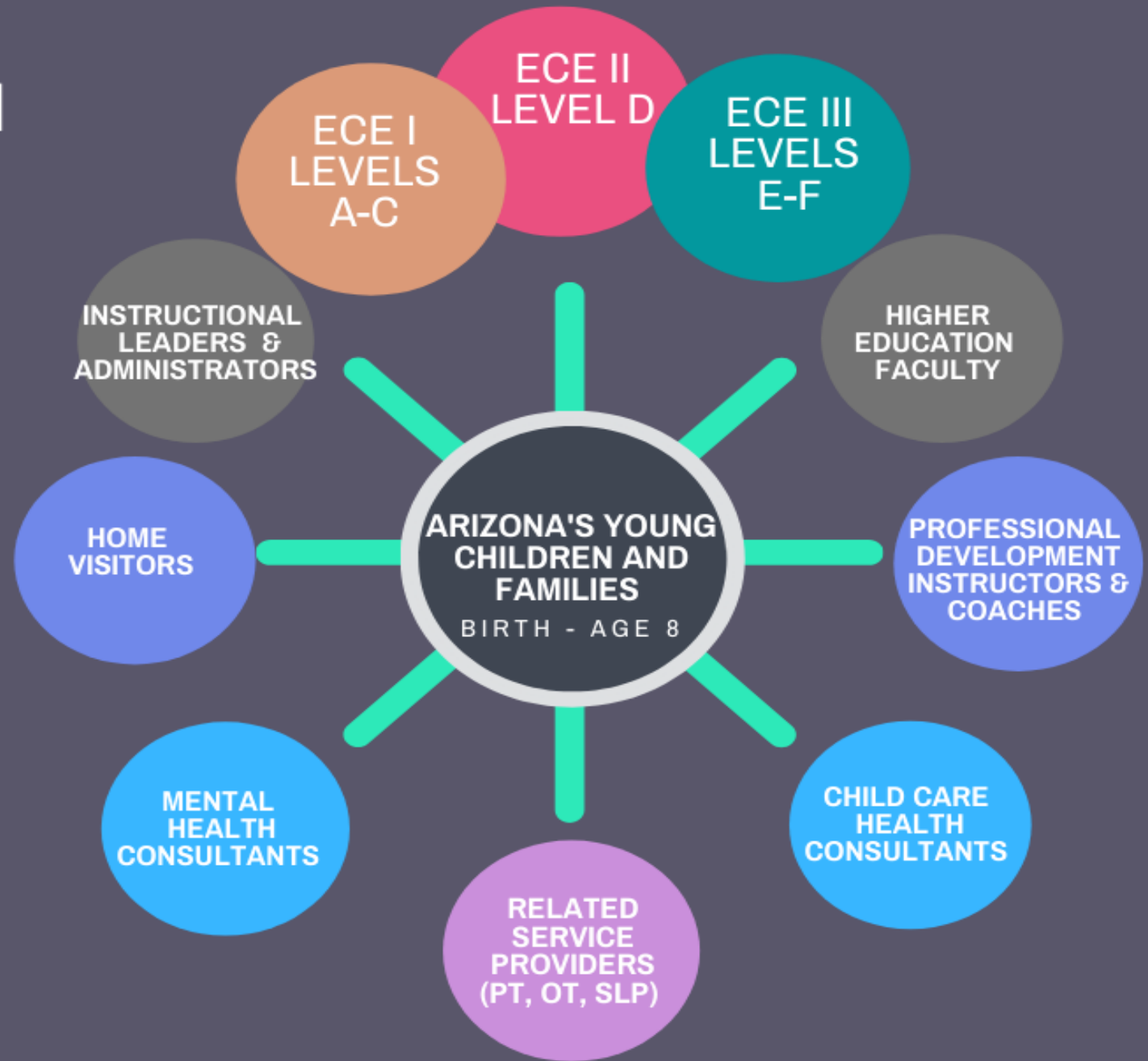
Arizona Early Childhood Field

Early childhood educators provide direct service to children birth through age 8 and are responsible for meeting the guidelines of the early childhood education profession.

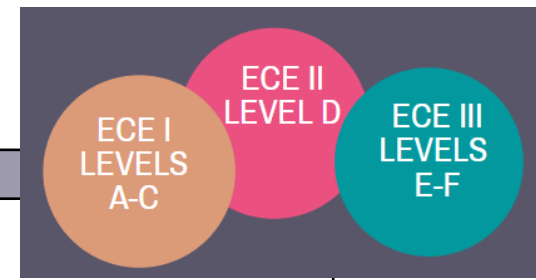
Instructional leaders / program administrators and higher education faculty guide the practice of early childhood educators.

Members of professions and occupations within the early childhood field, including those named here, *as well others not named here*, are responsible for meeting the guidelines of their respective professions.
